<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide a learning environment that is stimulating, safe and caring</li> <li>Treat everyone with respect</li> <li>Show unwavering belief in every individual</li> <li>Ensure that each student has the opportunities, support and guidance to achieve his/her full potential</li> <li>Report regularly on each student's progress</li> <li>Expect high standards, set clear rules, promote mutual respect and develop a sense of responsibility</li> <li>Keep parents informed about school matters, be welcoming to enquiries and being responsive to concerns</li> <li>Record and reward good progress and performance</li> <li>Offer co-curricular activities that will develop broader skills to prepare for life and the world of work</li> <li>Detain your child until 5.30 pm where necessary</li> <li>Inform you if your child has detention rather than attending co-curricular session if he/she fails to meet the School's standards</li> </ul>
